As well as being a fortification, its courtrooms have witnessed many famous trials over the centuries, including those of the Witches were Lancashire who convicted and sentenced to death in 1612. More than 400 years later you can visit the majestic court rooms and find out about the lives and experiences of the so-called Lancashire Witches. Manchester to Lancaster - 1 hour
